### WHAT DID PASTOR GASKIN PREACH ABOUT TODAY?

The Gospel of Jesus Christ is the climax of God's Salvation Mystery. Yes, a murder was committed in the Garden of Eden. Satan was the perpetrator. The victims of this crime were you and I. It corrupted our hearts and minds, and separated us from God. However, God sent his Son Jesus into the world not to catch and punish the perpetrator but to reconcile, revive and restore the victims. Jesus gave his life and arose from the death so that the Spirit of Christ could live in us. Now God blesses others through us, revealing his Glory, his great compassion.

## God's Salvation Mystery Christ in You, the Hope of Glory

- I. God has written a mystery, too. It is the very first mystery? It's a Salvation Mystery.
- II. If it were a novel, it would have interesting chapter names from "Deception in the Garden" to "the Son Rises on Sunday."
- III. Here we are ¾ quarters through the Bible and we still have figured out the point of the story.
- IV. Remember this is a Salvation Mystery not a Murder Mystery. It's about the victims not the perpetrator.

- V. Jesus Christ, the main character in God's salvation mystery, is not trying to catch and punish the devil but rather He is trying to reconcile, revive and restore you and me.
- VI. He wants to install Christ in us. Our software (hearts and minds) was corrupted in the garden, but Jesus has arrived with a new installation.
- VII. It is the Hope of Glory. We shine in this life because we are reconciled to God. When He calls us home to be with him His glory in us will continue in His presence.
