

WHAT DID PASTOR GASKIN PREACH ABOUT TODAY?

The Call to Discipleship has three parts: 1) a recommendation, usually from a close friend or loved one, 2) a personal encounter with Christ where he feeds your soul and impacts your life in a meaningful way, and 3) a direct requests that demands a direct response (RSVP). We should respond like Peter and decide to move Christ's priorities to the top of our agenda and follow Him. This means making the work and mission of the Freedom Church a major part of our lives. We are not called just to be saved by His grace. We are called to be disciples and fishers of men.

The Call for the Freedom Church Desire an RSVP Let's Say Yes Lord and Follow Him.

- I. Jesus sends a three-part invitation too. Let's look at Jesus' call to Peter to discipleship. (1 John 3:16-18)
- II. Peter was introduced to Christ by Andrew, his brother. Instead of an impersonal save the date card, we get a recommendation from a close relative or friend. (John 1:35-42)
- III. After meeting Jesus Christ, Peter had a personal experience with him. Jesus spoke to him and impacted his life. Peter was amazed. Everyone he calls has a similar experience. (Luke 5:1-11)

- IV. Jesus says, Follow me and I will make you a fisher of men. He is looking for an RSVP. Peter answered by putting his business aside and following Christ. (Matthew 4:18-20)
- V. How are you going to RSVP?
 ____Accept or ____Reject.
- VI. Save the Date, i.e. Drop something for Christ. Move Christ work and ministry to the top of our agenda. Make the Freedom Church an important part of your life. Also, remember you can bring guests with you. Jesus welcomes guests.

Words to Remember

One day as Jesus was standing by the Lake of Gennesaret, the people were crowding around him and listening to the word of God. He saw at the water's edge two boats, left there by the fishermen, who were washing their nets. He got into one of the boats, the one belonging to Simon, and asked him to put out a little from shore. Then he sat down and taught the people from the boat. When he had finished speaking, he said to Simon, "Put out into deep water, and let down the nets for a catch." Simon answered, "Master, we've worked hard all night and haven't caught anything. But because you say so, I will let down the nets." When they had done so, they caught such a large number of fish that their nets began to break. So they signaled their partners in the other boat to come and help them, and they came and filled both boats so full that they began to sink. When Simon Peter saw this, he fell at Jesus' knees and said, "Go away from me, Lord; I am a sinful man!" him. Luke 5:1-8
