WHAT DID PASTOR GASKIN PREACH ABOUT TODAY?

We must answer the call of the community for the Freedom Church. We cannot stand by watching others in need and withhold our gifts, talents and resources. We must show them the love of Jesus and respond to their need with love. This demonstrates true love for God and his people. We must love with action and in truth. We must use our gifts to bless God, the church and our communities. Failure to do so is to deny the love of Jesus in us. Answering the call requires sacrifice. But love always requires sacrifice. So let's show compassion and love.

*The Community is Calling for the Freedom Church
Love Compels Us to Answer the Call and Use Our Gifts.*

- I. Why should we answer the call? Why Zion? Why Us? **LOVE** (1 John 3:16-18)
- II. We have the vision to meet the needs of people in our community. We want to share compassion, health, scholarship and peace with them.
- III. Why us? We love the Lord and the Lord God has given us gifts and grace to make a difference.
- IV. Who should we show love to? Our Neighbors. Remember the Good Samaritan. (Luke 10:25-37)
- V. Jesus wants us to show mercy, and to love with action in truth.
- VI. Make the sacrifice and answer the call.
 1. Prophets evangelize and advocate.
 2. Servers serve and volunteer.
 3. Teachers teach and close that achievement gap.
 4. Encouragers inspire and motivate.
 5. Givers give to purpose.
 6. Administrators lead.
 7. Those full of mercy show mercy.
- VII. Someone knocking at the door. Answer it for **LOVE**.

Words to Remember

This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us. And we ought to lay down our lives for our brothers and sisters. If anyone has material possessions and sees a brother or sister in need but has no pity on them, how can the love of God be in that person? Dear children, let us not love with words or speech but with actions and in truth. (1 John 3:16-18, NIV)

“Which of these three do you think was a neighbor to the man who fell into the hands of robbers?” The expert in the law replied, “The one who had mercy on him.” Jesus told him, “Go and do likewise.” (Luke 10:36-37, NIV)
