WHAT DID PASTOR GASKIN PREACH ABOUT TODAY?

Parents make sure you teach your children wisdom. Help your children develop judgment so that they will make good decisions throughout their lives. Wisdom will help your children relate to God, themselves and others. Wisdom will bless your children if they embrace it. Wisdom comes with protection, praise, honor, grace and a glorious crown. Compel your children to listen and receive wisdom in their hearts. Remind them to remember wisdom and never turn away from it. Wisdom is paramount. It's the best gift!

Parents teach your children wisdom.

Wisdom is the Gift that Keeps on Giving

I. The most valuable thing you can give your children is wisdom. (Read Proverbs 4:1-9)

II. The father says to his sons, "Pay attention, I have something to teach you. Wisdom. Get in your heart. Don't forget it and don't forsake it. Wisdom will bless you."

III. Imparting Wisdom to your children is your most important responsibility as a parent.

IV. Why? Wisdom will tell your children how to live life successfully in God's eyes.

V. Wisdom tells us how to relate to God, ourselves, and to others.

VI. Wisdom will protect you, watch over you, exalt you, honor you, give you a garland of grace, and a glorious crown.

VII. Parents must (1) actively teach their children wisdom; (2) compel them to listen, learn, and remember; (3) get wisdom in their hearts; and (4) help them appreciate wisdom's value.

VIII. Help your child get wisdom and develop good judgment.

Words to Remember

Listen, my sons, to a father's instruction; **pay attention** and gain understanding. **I give you sound learning; so do not forsake my teaching.** For I too was a son to my father, still tender, and cherished by my mother. Then he taught me, and he said to me, "**Take hold of my words with all your heart; keep my commands, and you will live.** Get wisdom, get understanding; do not forget my words or turn away from them. **Do not forsake wisdom, and she will protect you; love her, and she will watch over you.** The beginning of wisdom is this: Get wisdom. Though it cost all you have, get understanding. Cherish her, and **she will exalt you;** embrace her, and she **will honor you.** She will give you a **garland to grace your head** and present you with a **glorious crown.**"
