## WHAT DID PASTOR GASKIN PREACH ABOUT TODAY?

We should come to church prepared to celebrate our salvation. We should sing our songs of praise and worship with a fresh appreciation for what God has done for us. We should sing like we are sing a new songs to the Lord. Why? The Lord is great and worthy of praise. He loves us and is faithful to us. He gives us victory over our enemies. Most of all, he saved our souls. Thus, God is worthy of our abundant praise. If we had 1000 tongues, we should dedicate each to praise Him for what he has done for us.

*Let's Sing a New Song to the Lord because He Saved Us.*

*Every Sunday should be a celebration of our evangelical conversion.*

- I. What are we doing during our praise and worship?
- II. Methodist Praise can be defined by Hymn #20 in the AME Zion Hymnal, O for a thousand tongues to sing by Charles Wesley (music by T. Hawies)
- III. Why did Charles Wesley write this Hymn.
- IV. This hymn commemorates the anniversaries of Charles' and John's Evangelical Conversions on May 21 and 24, 1738.
- V. Our worship should be a celebration of our evangelical conversion. We should sing a new song.
- VI. The Psalms give us 5 reasons to sing a new song: 1) The Lord is great and worthy of praise, 2) he loves us and is faithful, 3) he gives us victory over our enemies, 4) he enjoys hearing our praises, and 5) most of all he saved us.
- VII. Charles wants a thousand tongues to praise Him. What are we doing with our tongues?

## Words to Remember

Sing to the Lord a new song, **for he has done marvelous things; his right hand and his holy arm have worked salvation for him.** The Lord has made his salvation known and revealed his righteousness to the nations. He has remembered his love and his faithfulness to Israel; all the ends of the earth have seen the salvation of our God. (Psalm 98:1-3)
