WHAT DID PASTOR GASKIN PREACH ABOUT TODAY?

Our Class Meetings are crucial to the success of our church. We need to meet in our classes regularly to encourage each other to do good works, to help each other resist temptation, to make the changes in our lives we know God wants us to make, to comfort each other during difficult times, and to celebrate with each other our triumphs of faith. We should ask each other, "How is your spiritual life doing? Are you free and separated from sin?" Our church will grow if we attend our class meetings.

Christian Fellowship is Essential to Christian Growth.

We meet to instruct, encourage and admonish one another.

- I. The Class Meeting is the key building block of a vibrant Methodist congregation.
- II. John Wesley, the Holy Club and the 22 questions.
- III. The Lord encourages us to meet regularly to 1) encourage one another to do good deeds, 2) refrain from sin and 3) grow in our faith. (Heb. 10:24-25, Heb. 3:12-13, Prov. 27:17)
- IV. Mother Zion started as a Class Meeting in John Street Church.
- V. Our Class Meeting.
 - a. Sub-pastoral oversight
 - b. Instruct, encourage, and admonish
 - c. Help the church meet special financial goals.
- VI. Class leaders should 1) regularly meet with their members, 2) visit those who are absent and 3) advice, reprove, comfort and encourage them.
- VII. Keep Meeting! We keep our fire burning by sharing our fire.

Words to Remember

And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another – and all the more as you see the Day approaching. Heb. 10:24,25
