WHAT DID PASTOR GASKIN PREACH ABOUT TODAY?

The Black Panther movie inspires a Pan African feeling within us. It compels us to imagine an Africa that has not been exploited by Europe or Asian. We enjoy the dream of an Africa that has the full benefit of her people and her resources. Africa is beautiful, although Western society rarely celebrates or acknowledges her worth. However, can we imagine and see her beauty? Can we look in the mirror and see her splendor? If we dare to imagine and see her in our hearts, she can and will be. God has not forgotten her. Like other oppressed people God has a plan of deliverance and restoration for her. Yes. Generations have suffered but there will be generations that will prosper. Wakanda forever! This is a cry for Pan Africanism, a desire for Africa's children to come together to restore and celebrate Africa.

Can We See Wakanda in Us?

Wakanda is the Beautiful Africa Our Hearts Long For.

1. **Africa is Beautiful.** Check out the Africa you don't see on TV.
2. **Wakanda** is the Africa that has been untouched by European and Asian exploitation.
3. We are the African Diaspora and the offspring of the middle passage. "I am dream and hope of the slave. I rise." (M. Angelou)
4. We bear the scars of African colonization. We could not return to our Jerusalem.
5. Today Africa bears the scars of being robbed of her people and natural resources.
6. Wakanda gives us an opportunity to re-image ourselves. To think of ourselves absent the standard of American "whiteness"
7. Deep down we are in search of our identity. We identify with the oppressed people of the Bible, the Seed of Abram.
8. What does this mean? God has not forgotten us. He will punish our oppressors, restore homes and repay us for our lost.
9. Darrell's parable about 3 sisters.
10. **Wakanda gives us a Pan African feeling, and we like it.**
