

### WHAT DID PASTOR GASKIN PREACH ABOUT TODAY?

Jesus bore 39 lashes in his back that he might bear our grief and sorrows. His wounds heal us. He healed many in his earthly ministry. He healed people with physical and mental ailments. He healed people with minor illnesses and those who were dying. He healed everyone who came to him, great and small. He healed those who were too sick to come to him and needed others to come on their behalf. Jesus healed during biblical days and still heals today. Remember reach out to touch him by faith. Press through any barriers between you and the Lord. Remember even if your diagnosis is not good and your prognosis is poor, the Lord has the final say. Remember be persistent. Do not let anything discourage you. Call on the Lord until you get and answer. Jesus still heals.

## Jesus Still Heals Today. Your faith will make you whole.

### Jesus healed throughout Galilee. (Matthew 4:23, NIV)

- 1. Jesus healed the women with the issue of blood. She overcame the crowd and customs to have enough faith to touch the hem of his robe. Luke 8:42-48, NIV)
- 2. Jesus healed Jauris' daughter, even though he could not bring her to Jesus. Despite her dire diagnosis and poor prognosis, Jauris believed and fought off fear. He recognized that it ain't over until God says it's over. Luke 8:40-42, 49-56, NIV
- 3. Jesus healed blinded Bartimaeus who was begging by the roadside. Despite the crowd's efforts to discourage him,

Bartimaeus called on Jesus until he got an answer. Mark 10:46-52
