Justice or Judgement

1. There is a new vacancy on the Supreme Court. The so-called swing vote is retiring.
2. Historically, the Supreme Court has either upheld oppression or liberated the oppressed.
3. Supreme Court Mistakes Can Last for Generations. (Ask Dred Scott and Homer Plessy.)
4. The NAACP Legal Defense Fund and Thurgood Marshall used the Supreme Court to bring about change.
5. Conservatives Appear to Be Poised to Take the Court for a Generation.
6. Be Warned! Let's pray the President chooses wisely. God is Watching. Isaiah 10:1-4



7. Pray that the Supreme Court does not become a tool to promote racism, bigotry and oppression. Instead may it uphold justice of all.
8. God hates it when the law is used to oppress people. Eventually, the Lord will respond, "No justice! No peace!"

OUR BIBLICAL TEXT FOR TODAY

How terrible it will be for those who make unfair laws, and those who write laws that make life hard for people. They are not fair to the poor, and they rob my people of their rights. They allow people to steal from widows and to take from orphans what really belongs to them. How will you explain the things you have done? What will you do when your destruction comes from far away? Where will you run for help? Where will you hide your riches then? You will have to bow down among the captives or fall down among the dead bodies. But the Lord is still angry; his hand is still raised to strike down the people. Isaiah 10:1-4, NCV

What Did Pastor Gaskin Preach About Today?

The Supreme Court has been an important institution in American history. It has been used to support injustice as in the Dred Scott and Plessy decisions and to support justice as in the Brown decision. God hates an unjust court system that evil people use to oppress other people and rob them of their rights. The Bible says, "He is angry. His Hand is raised." Be warned! Judgement is waiting at the door. If our leaders make our courts unjust, God will respond, No justice! No peace!"

WHAT SHOULD I DO WITH THIS MESSAGE

1. Pray that the President and the Senate chooses wisely. Pray the Justices make wise decisions.
2. Make sure you participate in every election. There's no such thing as an unimportant election or wasted vote.
3. Don't support unfair laws even if they don't impact you, directly.
