- I. Do you have the Election Day Blues or even worse the 45 Blues?
- What is the Blues? The Blues is a negative mindset, assessment and perspective about one's life. It can be expressed musically.
- 3. Scholars believe African Americans in the South created the Blues during the post reconstruction period.
- 4. Instead of counting your blessings you count your sorrows and pain and resign yourself to despair.
- The Blues can come from many different sources.

- 9. The Joy of the Lord comes from the Holy Spirit. (Rom. 15:13 & Gal. 5:22-23)
