2. How should we deal with a cancerous member of the family?
3. Removal and killing won't bring about healing.
4. Instead try to transform the cancerous family member into a healthy family member.

 - b. Forgive and practice mercy.

 - c. Learn how to reconcile. It can restore and heal relationships.
Matthew 18:15-17
 - d. Treat the unrepentant like God treats unsaved people, with love and kindness from a distance. Matt 5:43-48



OUR BIBLICAL TEXT FOR TODAY

Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everyone. If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone. Do not take revenge, my dear friends, but leave room for God's wrath, for it is written: "It is mine to avenge; I will repay," says the Lord. On the contrary: "If your enemy is hungry, feed him; if he is thirsty, give him something to drink. In doing this, you will heap burning coals on his head." Do not be overcome by evil but overcome evil with good. Romans 12:17-21, NIV

Healthy families know how to forgive and reconcile. They overcome evil with good.

"If your brother or sister sins, go and point out their fault, just between the two of you. If they listen to you, you have won them over. But if they will not listen, take one or two others along, so that 'every matter may be established by the testimony of two or three witnesses.' If they still refuse to listen, tell it to the church; and if they refuse to listen even to the church, treat them as you would a pagan or a tax collector. Matt 18:15-17. NIV

What did Pastor Gaskin Preach About?

Healthy families must practice forgiveness and reconciliation. This is the only way to deal effectively with cancerous family members. Forgive them and practice mercy for your sake. This will help you let go of the anger and pain they have caused you. Try to reconcile but this requires confrontation and forgiveness on your part and acknowledgement and repentance on theirs. If they do their part, the relationship will heal and a restoration will follow. If they are unrepentant, treat them like God treats the unsaved sinner. He loves them from a distance. He be kind to them when he can be. But they don't really have fellowship with him. Therefore, put your cancerous family member in God's hands. Overcome evil with good.

WHAT SHOULD I DO WITH THIS MESSAGE

1. Don't seek revenge on family members who hurt you.
2. Forgive family members who have hurt you.
3. Try to reconcile but if they won't do their part, be kind anyway.
