Why Observe Lent?

1. Lent is about Pruning.
2. Why do gardeners prune plants?
To cut off unfruitful parts, to shape and promote growth.
3. Why are branches unfruitful?
 - a. The former harvest season is over, and the remnants of old growth must be removed.
 - b. There's an unhealthy growth that has infected the branch.
4. During Lent, the Lord wants us to
 - a. recognize things we have to remove or reduce because they are out of season
 - b. recognize unhealthy things we need to remove
5. God requires *simultaneous abiding*, i.e., Christ is in me and I am in Christ.
 - a. This is key to fruitfulness.
 - b. The Word is the source of life.
 - c. Given him access to your whole life
6. When we achieve simultaneous abiding our prayers are aligned with God's will and our lives become more productive.



OUR BIBLICAL TEXT FOR TODAY

¹ "I am the true vine, and my Father is the gardener. ² He cuts off every branch in me that bears no fruit, while every branch that does bear fruit he prunes so that it will be even more fruitful. ³ You are already clean because of the word I have spoken to you. ⁴ Remain in me, as I also remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain in me. ⁵ "I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing. ⁶ If you do not remain in me, you are like a branch that is thrown away and withers; such branches are picked up, thrown into the fire and burned. ⁷ If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. ⁸ This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples. John 15:1-8, NIV

The Goal of Lent: fast and pray so that we align ourselves with Christ, so He is in us and we are in Him.

⁴ Take delight in the Lord, and he will give you the desires of your heart. ⁵ Commit your way to the Lord; trust in him and he will do this. Psalms 37:4-5, NIV

What did Pastor Gaskin Preach About?

Use this Lenten Season to allow God to prune you of habits, activities and obligations that will not be fruitful in the season you are about to enter. The remnants of past successes have to be removed to make room for new victories. Sinful infections must be cleaned out to allow for healing and healthy growth. Studying and meditating on the Word of God allows us to remain in him and he in us. This simultaneous abiding is like super grow fertilizer. It makes our prayers and life fruitful to the glory of God the Father.

WHAT SHOULD I DO WITH THIS MESSAGE

1. Make time to participate in the Church's Lenten Season readings. (This is more important than changing your diet.)
2. Find a Bible-based reading that's personal as a supplement to the Church's Lenten Season readings.
3. Pray and ask God to prune you to make room for new growth and success.
