Know His Resurrection Power

1. Lord I'm Running, Trying to Make 100, 99½ won't due.
2. Our Goal is to Know His Resurrection Power.
3. What is resurrection? It is the rising from the dead, the restoration of life, or revival.
4. Jesus teaches us about his resurrection power through the death of Lazarus. *John 11:1-43*
5. Sickness and death must precede resurrection then we see His glory. *John 11:4*
6. Resurrection power is designed to increase our faith in God. *John 11:14, 15*
7. Jesus is the resurrection and life. *John 11:25-26*
8. Some things may be sick in your life or may have died. They are opportunities for Jesus to demonstrate his resurrection power so you will see His Glory.
9. Have you heard Jesus call to your Lazarus, "Come Out!"?



OUR BIBLICAL TEXT FOR TODAY

¹⁰ I want to know Christ—yes, to know the power of his resurrection and participation in his sufferings becoming like him in his death.

What has died in your life? Call on Jesus. He Might Come and Use His Resurrection Power to Restore It.

Now a man named Lazarus was sick.... ⁴ When he heard this, Jesus said, "This sickness will not end in death. What did Pastor Gaskin Preach About?

So, don't be dismayed, death is not the end, it is only the setting for the most important faith building event in your life. Jesus is the resurrection and the life. He has power over death, hell and the grave. He restores those good things that death tries to take from you. When He does it, your faith in God will grow; and you will have a closer relationship with God. Every Christian should understand the depth and breadth of His resurrection power.

1. Reflect on your life's journey. Has Jesus ever restored something good to you that you watched died and had buried? What was it?
2. Make sure you know his resurrection power, if something good dies in your life, call on Jesus.
