Five Elements of Successful Plans

1. "I like it when a plan comes together."
2. A Successful Plan Starts with Your **Passion**. It must be about something you want. (Nehemiah 1:4 & 2:1)
3. **Pray** to God and ask him for favor to achieve your goal. Remember it's about the goal not the process. (Nehemiah 1:5-11 & 2:4)
4. What do you need God to **Provide**? Know what you need to accomplish your goal. (Nehemiah 2:4 & 2:6)
5. Be **Prepare!** Study your situation. Know the status of your plan. (Nehemiah 2:11-16)
6. Be ready to **Present** your plan to all stakeholders. This includes the king, people, opposition and the Lord. Have one presentation for each. (Nehemiah 2:17-18)

OUR BIBLICAL TEXT FOR TODAY

¹¹ I went to Jerusalem, and after staying there three days ¹² I set out during the night with a few others. I had not told anyone what my God had put in my heart to do for Jerusalem. There were no mounts with me except the one I was riding on.

¹³ By night I went out through the Valley Gate toward the Jackal Well and the Dung Gate, examining the walls of Jerusalem, which had been broken down, and its gates, which had been destroyed by fire. ¹⁴ Then I moved on toward the Fountain Gate and the King's Pool, but there was not enough room for my mount to get through; ¹⁵ so I went up the valley by night, examining the wall. Finally, I turned back and reentered through the Valley Gate. ¹⁶ The officials did not know where I had gone or what I was doing, because as yet I had said nothing to the Jews or the priests or nobles or officials or any others who would be doing the work.

¹⁷ Then I said to them, "You see the trouble we are in: Jerusalem lies in ruins, and its gates have been burned with fire. Come, let us rebuild the wall of Jerusalem, and we will no longer be in disgrace." ¹⁸ I also told them about the gracious hand of my God on me and what the king had said to me. They replied, "Let us start rebuilding." So they began this good work.
